Last spring, Erica and I went to the Oklahoma Harness Horse Association's Beginning Driving Clinic in Stillwater. The clinic was tremendous fun – I learned how to harness a horse, how to actually drive a horse and carriage, and learned more about carriages and buggies than I ever imagined. And if that weren't enough, it turns out that the lady who runs my tack shop in OKC is part of this organization. And on top of that, she had a friend who was selling a well-made Amish harness that just happened to be exactly the same price as the balance in my show budget that month. What are the odds? Typical to my impulsive nature, I jumped into this driving thing with both my feet and all four of Faroh's. As usual, he was the youngest horse in his class, and all of us were soundly thrashed by a huge Clydesdale stallion that was in full harness: clanking chains and the whole nine yards. We all groveled before him and called him "king of the harness" and let him win without protest. We were afraid he'd squash us under his front shoes if we complained. They looked like size 11's.

**Item: Financial Report:** Dedra Tiger passed out the financial report provided by Angie McGee. Motion made by Pat Gent to approve the financial report as written. Second by Gary Lukicik. Motion passed.

**Item: June Show Results:** Dedra Tiger passed out the June Show Results Report Sooner added 12 memberships. After expenses, the show profit was \$2110.00. Discussion about the positive increase and financial health of the club.

**Item: Futurity Prep:** Carol Johnson reported that Thomas Keeling has agreed to judge the Sooner Futurity Class. The Futurity Class for the October Show will be held after Class 4. It will be a halter format class.

**Item: October Show:** Discussion of fundraising and silent auction. Discussion of need to increase our visibility by hanging posters in members local areas. We need volunteers to work! Pat suggested the Sundance Pony Club which is based in Stillwater and has in the past helped with other organizations' shows -- ODS, OHHA, and Payne County Livestock Show. Contact person is Chrissi Fredeirman. Additional ideas included OSU equine department students. We already have several stall reservations.

**Item: Stall No-Shows:** Discussion of the number of no-shows in June and how it costs the club money to set up additional stalls and then have empty stalls due to no-shows. We cannot continue to financially support this. Discussion centered on charging a non-refundable stall deposit, to be deducted from the stall fee at the end of the show. Motion made by Pat Gent : That there be an \$8 non-refundable stall fee as part of the stall reservation process. Said stall fee shall be deducted from the total stall fee at check out. Without stall deposit being paid, no stalls shall be reserved and available stalls shall be assigned first come, first served. Second by Dedra Tiger. Motion passed.

**Item: CPO clinic with October Show:** Discussion of API and need for CPO. There were questions regarding cost and feasibility or even necessity since API has been passed in first draft by the ApHC board. Motion made by Pat Gent to table this item until after ApHC rules on A.P.I. and we have more information about cost and feasibility. Second by Carol Johnson. Motion passed.

**Item: Upcoming Events:** September Show Committee Meeting to be held September 11 at Goldies in Claremore, 3pm. Items for discussion at this meeting shall be the Judges List
